Annual Snapshot: Report Card



ESSA requires all states to develop and publish report cards for all schools. Vermont does this through our Annual Snapshot. Vermont's school report card will provide data on school performance and change for the five domains of the Education Quality Standards. Each domain has multiple indicators of success. The strengths and needs identified through the Annual Snapshot will guide the school needs assessment and continuous improvement. The Annual Snapshot will allow the public to look at broad measures of school performance and drill down to look at individual indicators and grade level and student group performance, provided the number of students is sufficient to report the data. Please note that the Annual Snapshot presented below is only a sample to demonstrate the concepts the tool will address.
