

Indicator 1 - Graduation

Reported in both the statewide and local APR. The reported graduation rate of students with IEPs is an event graduation rate, calculated by dividing the count of students with IEPs who graduated in a given year by the count of students with IEPs who exited special education during that year by graduating, earning a certificate, reaching the maximum age, or dropping out.

$$\text{Indicator 1} = \frac{\text{Number of students with IEPs who graduated}}{\text{Number of students with IEPs who exited special education}} \times 100$$

Data Sources: Same data as used for reporting to the Department under section 618 of the IDEA, using the definitions in ED Facts file specification C009.
