

## Indicator 14 – Postsecondary Outcomes

Reported in both the statewide and local APR.

Measure A: Percent of youth who are no longer in secondary school, had IEPs in effect at the time they left school, and were enrolled in higher education within one year of leaving high school.

$$\text{Indicator 14 Measure A} = \frac{\text{Number of youth enrolled in higher education within one year of leaving high school}}{\text{Number of respondent youth no longer in high school who had IEPs in effect at the time they left school}} \times 100$$

Measure B: Percent of youth who are no longer in secondary school, had IEPs in effect at the time they left school, and were enrolled in higher education or competitively employed within one year of leaving high school.

$$\text{Indicator 14 Measure B} = \frac{\text{Number of youth enrolled in higher education or competitively employed within one year of leaving high school}}{\text{Number of respondent youth no longer in high school who had IEPs in effect at the time they left school}} \times 100$$

Measure C: Percent of youth who are no longer in secondary school, had IEPs in effect at the time they left school, and were enrolled in higher education or in some other postsecondary education or training program; or competitively employed or in some other employment within one year of leaving high school.

$$\text{Indicator 14 Measure C} = \frac{\text{Number of youth enrolled in higher education or other postsecondary education/training; or competitively employed or in other employment within one year of leaving high school}}{\text{Number of respondent youth no longer in high school who had IEPs in effect at the time they left school}} \times 100$$

Data Source: Telephone survey with attempts to contact every student who exited high school in the prior year. Family members may respond if they are knowledgeable about the student.
